

RUIDOSO NOON LIONS SUPPORT CHRISTIAN SERVICES OF LINCOLN COUNTY

On 16 January 2006 during a Noon Meeting, the Ruidoso Noon Lions Club presented Mr. Arthur Hoops a check for \$1000 for Christian Services of Lincoln County. Christian Services is a non-profit charitable organization that is sponsored by several local churches, clubs, organizations, businesses, and individuals in the Ruidoso area.

The organization maintains a clothing room and food bank at the Gateway Church of Christ building on Sudderth Drive which is stocked with items donated by the community. Christian Services also distributes federal funds through an Emergency Food Box Program. There is no charge for assistance or services. Most clients are those folks who are homeless, unemployed, ill, elderly, indigent, fleeing domestic violence or provider abandonment, or those who are facing a sudden change in family responsibilities. On average, 50 to 100 folks will be helped each week with clothing and food provisions. Christian Services volunteers also collect and distribute other items such as furniture and appliances to needy families.
